Reception.... Reception have been busy noticing, describing and creating patterns this week. We looked at patterns in nature and talked about we might see in Spring. We created repeating patterns with beads, pegs, chalks, paint and shapes. We worked hard on practising writing tricky words and sentences with finger spaces. Please remember to listen to your child read regularly and go on Bug Club!

Year 2...We started the week by making delicious cupcakes and then used this activity to write instructions. We also created art work as part of our habitat topic and learned about money in maths. You can help at home by making sure you ask your child lots of questions when they read.

Year 4... This week, Year 4 went to 'We The Curious' and started their Basketball lessons with Bristol Flyers. At 'We The Curious' we learnt all about circuits and we even made our own to take home, using playdough! At home, please practise 6 and 7 times tables. Year 1....This week we began reading 'The Snail and the Whale' by our focus author: Julia Donaldson. We have been 'adjective detectives'; finding adjectives in the story to then use in our own descriptions. In maths we learnt about capacity and volume and had fun testing out our ideas using rice. At home please help by asking the children to describe things you see using adjectives (describing words).

Year 3... This week Year 3 started swimming! In Maths we started looking at tenths and in English we got to know our new adventure text. We also started a new topic and are now learning all about volcanos and earthquakes. It has been a busy first week back for us! At home, please talk to your child about what they have learned in their rainforest topic so far.

Year 5... This week we explored the exciting world of fantasy. We are reading a book called Frogspell, which is all about the adventure of a brother and sister. In English we discovered all sorts of a new vocabulary and wrote spell poems with rhyming couplets. At home, please help your child to learn their spellings.

Year 6... We have done things quite differently this week in Year 6, with children working in smaller groups with different adults from normal. We are getting ready for the SATs and the children have worked very hard. We have revised money, timetables and graphs – all in one week! We also revised word classes with a focus on pronouns and determiners. We had our first week of swimming this week too, which we very much enjoyed. At home, ask your child mental "what is the difference" questions. For example, "what is the difference between £5 and £1.27?"


