# What have we been learning?

**Reception...** have been getting ready to celebrate Jack's birthday! We practised adding, taking away, doubling and sharing in Maths and working with money to buy a present in the shop. We enjoyed sharing more special things from home. Thank you.  
**At home, please look at coins eg. 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p. Pretend to buy something. Take away to work out how much is left.**

**Year 2...** we have been writing a recount about the heroic Grace Darling. In Maths, we used our reasoning skills and learning to work systematically. In Topic we have looked at sources and made inferences about people's feelings. **You can help at home by continuing to read with your child and talk about the books**

**Year 5...** have been preparing to write reports about King Arthur. In Maths, we have put decimal numbers into sequences and multiplied and divided decimal numbers by 10, 100 and 1000. **At home, please ensure your child reads for 20 minutes each day. Talk to your child about what they have read.**

**Year 6...** have finished their SATs week! Children worked really hard to show off their very best. All the adults that have worked with them over the last year are feeling very proud. In the afternoons, they have been working on their graffiti project and produced their very own tags. **At home, please enjoy a well-earned rest over the weekend, ready for the last week of term.**

**Year 1...** We wrote directions to the chickens and played games where we directed partners using forward, backward, clockwise and anticlockwise. We have also begun telling the time to the nearest hour on a clock. Our caterpillars have begun making cocoons – we are excited to see our butterflies soon! **Please help your child to tell the time on a clock to the nearest hour and half past the hour.**

**Year 3...** we began telling the time in Maths. In English we wrote non-chronological reports all about our amazing school. At home, please practise reading clocks and telling the time with your children.

**Year 4...** we have been exploring the features of non-chronological reports and making notes on all kinds of cats. In Maths, they have been showing how much they have learnt about money and time. **At home, support your child to practise times tables up to 12.**
