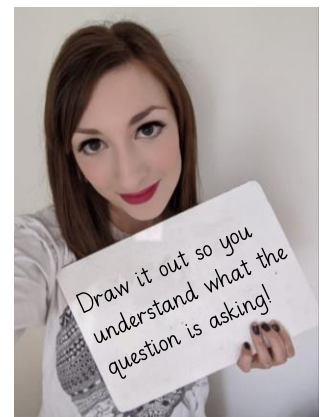
4. Ben has 16 marbles. He shares them equally between his two friends.

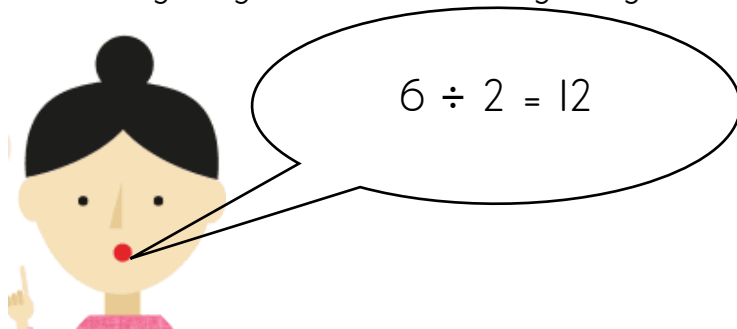
5. Ikram has 22 socks. She puts them into groups of 2.
