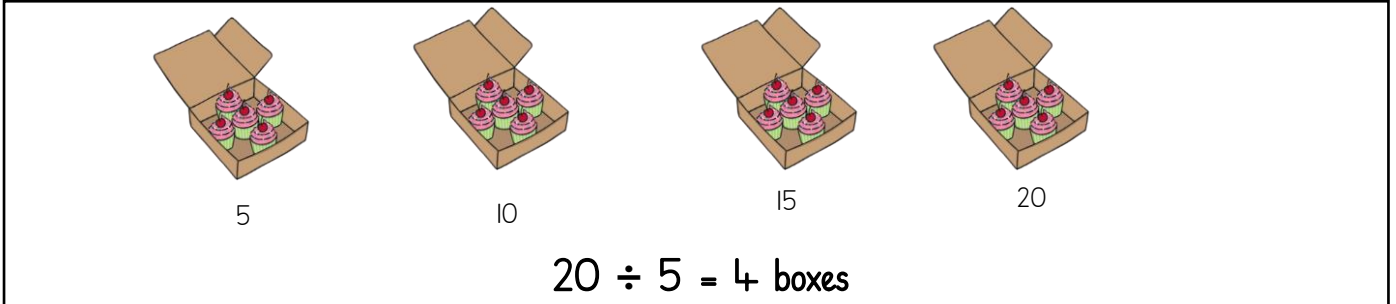


Wednesday – division word problems

Today you have a mixture of sharing and grouping word problems. Can you **draw out** what the question is asking in your books and then write the number sentence.

Example:

Ann has 20 cakes she puts 5 cakes in each box. How many boxes does she need?



5 10 15 20

$20 \div 5 = 4 \text{ boxes}$

1. Mohamed has 14 pencils. He puts 2 pencils in each pot. How many pots does he need?
2. Miss Ellison-Smith has 10 rubbers. She shares them between 10 children. How many rubbers does each child get?
3. A squirrel has 15 nuts. He puts 5 nuts in each hole. How many holes does he have?
4. A pet shop owner has 18 fish. He shares them between 2 tanks. How many fish are in each tank?
5. Kimi has 12 sweets. She shares them between herself and her two friends. How many sweets do they get each?
