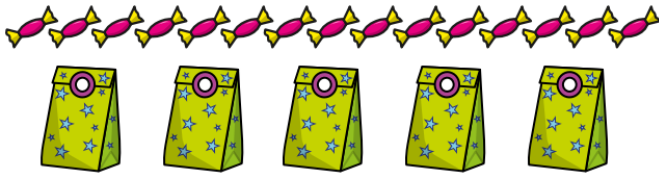
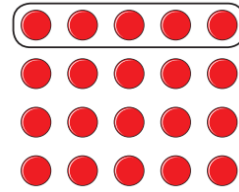


# Tuesday – divide by 5
