1. Can you write the division number sentences these pictures are showing?



$$10 \div 2 = 5$$



$$12 \div 2 = 6$$

2. Can you solve these division number sentences?

$$10 \div 2 = 5$$

$$18 \div 2 = 9$$

$$4 \div 2 = 2$$

$$\text{twenty} \div \text{two} = 10$$

$$\text{fourteen} \div \text{two} = 7$$

$$0 \div 2 = 0$$

3. Can you fill in the missing numbers?

$$6 \div 2 = 3$$

$$10 \div 2 = 5$$

$$12 \div 2 = 6$$

$$20 \div 2 = 10$$

4. Ben has 16 marbles. He shares them equally between his two friends.

How many marbles do they get each?

$$16 \div 2 = 8$$

8 marbles

5. Ikram has 22 socks. She puts them into groups of 2.

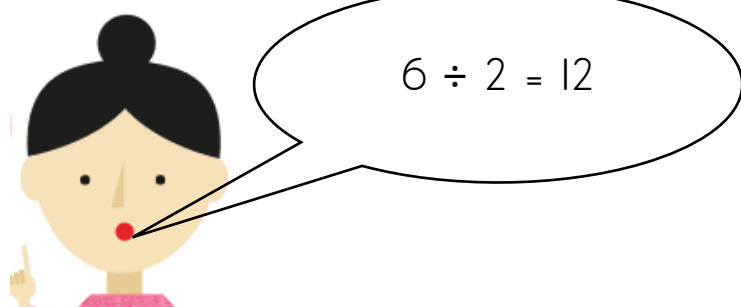
How many groups does she have?

$$22 \div 2 = 11$$

11 groups of socks



6. Do you agree with Sara? Why/ why not?



I disagree with Sara because

$$6 \times 2 = 12$$

$$\text{but } 6 \div 2 = 3.$$
