We are currently planning a gradual return to school from 1st June. The government have said that reception, year 1 and year 6 can return first. Our top priority is to make sure those who wish to return do so as safely as possible. We need to carefully risk assess all elements of the school day and make changes where needed. Government guidance is that children mix with a just a small number of other children, to minimise the risk of infection. We are making careful plans to ensure this can happen. We have been waiting for more information from the local authority, so full information will be sent out early next week by text and email - this will also be on the school website.

Thank you for all the messages and feedback we have had this week; it is lovely to hear from you all during this difficult time. We have also enjoyed seeing some of you when you have come to collect books, learning resources, art kits and food boxes.

This week we distributed lots of books. 'Friends of Hannah More' were delighted to receive a £1,000 grant from Sovereign Housing, which we used to buy 190 books for children in all year groups. Many of you will have now received a book - please send us your pictures, reviews and comments!

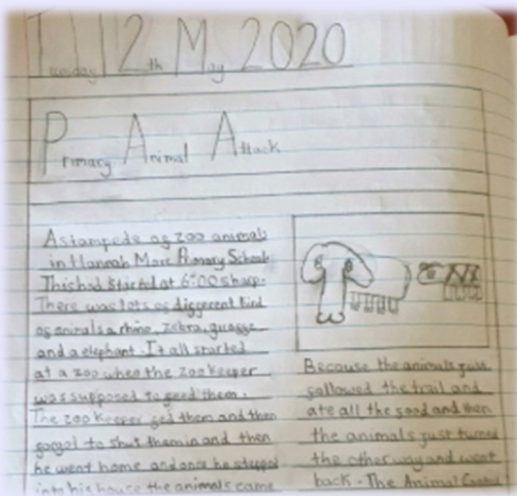
