What have we been learning?

Year 1... This week we hosted the end of our term Enquiry: a Hat Walk! We loved showing off our final designs to our parents and then showing our work back in our classrooms. We also wrote up our own stories in literacy, and learnt how to add in maths. Please read with your child every day, and encourage them to answer questions about the book.

Year 3...This week Year 3 had a visit from some archaeologists that we met on our trip last week. We became medieval builders and then archaeologists for the afternoon. As writers we started our new Rama and Sita story as the focus for our learning and as mathematicians we practised using the column method for adding and subtracting. Read lots at home with your child and ask them questions about what they are reading. Remind your child to bring in their PE kit on **Tuesdays** next term.

Year 5 ...We had a busy week creating our space documentaries this week. We had to film them, edit them and also add in pictures and music to make them more engaging for our audience. We enjoyed sharing these documentaries with our parents this afternoon At home, ask your child to practise their times tables for the maths learning next term.

Year 2... This week we performed our musical – 'People Who Help Us' to the school and parents. We did a fantastic job with our acting and singing! We also did our enquiry challenge where we planned out a classroom including details of all the materials we needed. Over the holidays please read with your child every day. Continue to practice adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers..

Year 4...We had a fab week this week. We explored a poem called 'The Sound Collector' and have wrote our own versions of the poem in which we collected sounds from the school. In maths, we used the skills we have been learning all term to solve problems and investigate! At home, please practise times tables up to 12 with your child.

Year 6... In maths, we learned to find common multiples, factors and prime numbers and to use the order of operations. In English, we wrote alternate endings to our class story Beetle Boy. In enquiry, we made created model animals designed to survive an imaginary habitat. At home, please ensure children practise their tables up to 12x12 every day over half term!
