

Origami: How good are you at following instructions. Here are a set of two instructions for you to try to follow. Please take pictures of the end result and post them to our school email or twitter account! An ordinary sheet of paper will do so long as you make it into a square first!



Step 1: Start with a square piece of origami paper. If you only have regular 8.5x11 paper, follow these instructions to make a square sheet. You can also use these colorful [Printable Origami Paper](#).



Step 2: Fold the paper in half by folding the top corner to the bottom corner. You should have an upside down triangle.



Step 3: Fold part of the top down so that the edge is about halfway down. Don't make this flap too thin because this will become the wings.



Step 4: Turn the paper over.



Step 5: Take the bottom corner of the top layer and fold it up like this.



Step 6: Fold the figure in half by folding the left side over to the right.



Step 7: Now fold that same flap back like this to make one of the wings.



Step 8: Fold the other wing back also.



Step 9: Push the center of the head in and flatten. This is called an inside reverse fold.



Now try making this car.



Step 1: Start with a square sheet of origami paper, color side down. If you only have regular rectangle paper, follow instructions on [how to make origami paper](#).

Step 2: Fold the paper in half, top to bottom, then unfold.



Step 3: Now fold the paper in half again, left to right, and unfold again.



Step 4: Fold the bottom edge to the center crease.



Step 5: Diagonally fold down the left and right side of the bottom flap. This forms the wheels.

Step 6: Fold down the top part at the horizontal crease, covering the wheels entirely.



Step 7: Now fold about 3/4 of it back up.



Step 8: Fold down the top right corner like the picture.



Step 9: Turn the figure over and now you know how to make an origami car! Just draw on the windows and doors and you can design your own dream car!
