We are waiting for a new order to arrive as we have run out of some sizes. This should be with us in 2 weeks, we will send a text out to let you know.





If we are worried that a child may have Coronavirus (for example if they have a cough, or a temperature) we will:

- Take the child to a separate space, away from other people
- Ask the child and the adult who is looking after them to put on a face mask
- Phone parents straight away
- Stay safely with the child until a parent or carer collects them

When you collect your child and your other children you will be asked to get everyone tested for Coronavirus. We have test kits in school, or you can go to a test centre - the nearest is at Netham Park. Your family must self-isolate until you get the test result. If the test is positive you will then need to self-isolate for 14 days. If you have any concerns you can speak to the school office.
