Reception

Reception have had a busy and creative week! The children worked hard with practising the nativity really enjoyed performing it to the school and parents. The children made some brilliant Christmas pictures and we have enjoyed our Christmas party! At home, please read over the holidays, and have a restful break.

Year 1 have had a busy week! As mathematicians we learnt all about different 2D and 3D shapes and practised recognising them and naming them in a shape hunt. We also held our Toy Museum and loved sharing all our new knowledge as historians and tour guides! At home please read with your child as much as possible over the holidays. Practise number bonds to 10 and count forwards and backwards to 20. Ask your child to practise naming and finding 3D shapes in your homes.

Year 2 What an exciting week Year 2 have had with Christmas lunch, class treats and parties. They have finished studying money as mathematicians and learnt about apostrophes for contraction in English. Please read with your child as much as possible over the holidays. Teach your child how to count in 3s. Show your child the different coins and note when buying things in shops. Ask them to select the right amount of money and talk about change.

This week we learnt all about Jackson Pollock the artist and used his style to make some fantastic paintings. We have also been authors and published our non-chronological report all about volcanoes! Please read with your child as often as possible and encourage them to practise their times tables.

Year 4 The week we have been busy publishing our non-chronological reports on British wildlife. We also worked as artists to craft collages of different animals. We had a fantastic trip this week to Belmont Estate, where we explored the outdoors, met different animals and got very muddy and wet! At home please read with your child and help them to practise their times tables.

This week we performed our incredible performance of 'The Snow Queen', though we have also been extremely busy as mathematicians and writes. We learnt about short division with remainders and writing scripts. Please read with your child and help them to practise their times tables.



This week Year 6 have been multiplying and dividing fractions and writing letters in role, summarising events and portraying emotion. We also used watercolours to create effective anatomy paintings. Please help your child with their times tables and reading.
