

Character Planning

This week, we are going to be writing a story. To start with, we want you to plan your main character. Below is an example of mine!

1. Do a quick drawing of your character in the middle.
2. Think about the different personality traits they have - put these in clouds
3. Then next to each cloud, write the things they do that show this personality trait.

Use mine to help you. You should fill the page.
