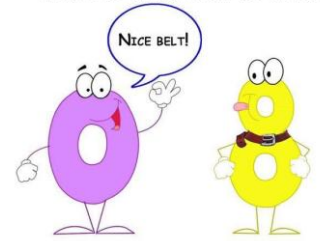


Mrs W's Maths 8 **ANSWERS**
 Multiplying by 10, 100 and 1000



- 1 When we multiply by 10, the digits move 1 place to the left.
 $76 \times 10 = 760$

1000s	100s	10s	1s
		7	6
	7	6	0

- 2 When we multiply by 100, the digits move 2 places to the left
 $35 \times 100 = 3500$

1000s	100s	10s	1s
		3	5
3	5	0	0

- 3 When we multiply by 1000, the digits move 3 places to the left
 $28 \times 1000 = 28000$

- 4 Multiplying makes numbers bigger

1000s	100s	10s	1s

Write the number sentence $45 \times 10 = 450$

- 5 This number was multiplied by 100, what was the start number? 13

1000s	100s	10s	1s
		1	3

- 6 Use the same start number

Start number	X 10	X 100	X 1000
7	70	700	7000
24	240	2400	24000
369	3690	36900	369000
50	500	5000	50000
603	6030	60300	603000
