Contractions

Contractions are where two words are shortened to make one word. Some letters are dropped and replaced by an apostrophe to show where the missing letter or letters were.

Example: they will  they'll


Here you can see the apostrophe replaces the 'wi' in will. Now you have a go.

In all these contractions the apostrophe replaces **more than one letter**. Think carefully which letters are replaced and if it looks right.
