

## Friday – 5 past and 10 past

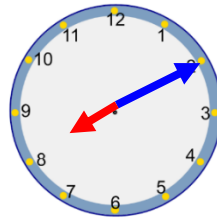
When the **minute hand** (longer hand) is pointing to the 1 it means 5 past.

When the **minute hand** is pointing to the 2 it means 10 past.

At 5 past and 10 past the **hour hand** (shorter hand) will be just past the hour.



**5 past**  
Minute hand is on the 1.  
Hour hand is just past the 8.  
The time is 5 past 8.



**Ten past**  
Minute hand is on the 2.  
Hour hand is just past the 8.  
The time is ten past 8.

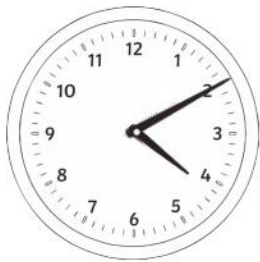


The minute hand is on the 2.

The time is 10 past 2.



The minute hand is on the 1.  
The hour hand is just past the 12.  
The time is 5 past 12.
