

Friday – 'er' or 'est' suffix

Rule:

er – this suffix means 'more' and is used for comparative adjectives where two things are being compared for example in the sentence: *15cm is longer than 10cm*

est – this suffix means 'most' and is used for superlative adjectives where more than 2 things are being compared and this is the 'most' of the group compared for example in the sentence: *Usain Bolt is the fastest man in the world.*
