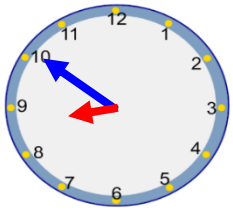


Thursday – 10 to and 5 to

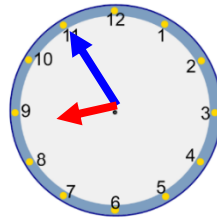
When the **minute hand** (longer hand) is pointing to the 10 it means 10 to.

When the **minute hand** is pointing to the 11 it means 5 to.

At 5 to and 10 to the **hour hand** (shorter hand) is nearly at the next hour.



10 to
Minute hand is on the 10.
Hour hand is nearly at the 9.
The time is 10 to 9.



5 to
Minute hand is on the 11.
Hour hand is nearly to the 9.
The time is 5 to 9.
