

# Tuesday

Today we are going to be focusing on finding the difference. When we **find the difference** and work out **how much more or less** someone has, we need **to subtract**. Remember to **take away from the bigger number!**

1) Three children have saved their pocket money. Here is what they each have in their piggy banks:



Charlie

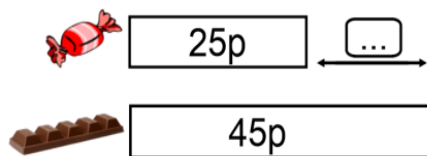


Jessica



Becky

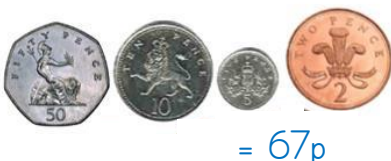
- How much more does Jessica have than Becky?  $£11 - £6 = £5$ . The answer is £5.
- What is the difference between Charlie's and Jessica's amount of money?  $£15 - £11 = £4$
- What is the difference between Becky and Charlie's savings?  $£15 - £6 = £9$



2) Work out **the difference** between the price of the sweet and chocolate and fill in the missing numbers in the number sentence.

$$45p - 25p = 20p$$

3) Bilal has these coins. He wants to buy a toy car for 80p. **How much more** money does he need?



$$80p - 67p = 13p$$

Bilal needs 13p more.

4) Find the difference between these amounts.

- Bob has 63p. Amy has 75p. The difference is 12p
- Roy has £14 and Sita has £30. The difference is £16
- Mr Cook has £2 and 50p. Miss Skinner has £1 and 50p. The difference is £1
- Miss Goodwin has £10 and 20p and Miss Campbell has £9 and 10p. The difference is £1 and 10p
- Mr Rossetti has 80p and Miss Mahmood has £1. The difference is 20p (because 100p = £1 remember!)

5) Mr Webster tried to find the difference between £35 and £50.

What mistake has he made? The mistake is Mr Webster added the numbers when he should have subtracted to find the difference.  $50 - 35 = £15$

He said " $35 + 50 = £85$   
so £85 is the difference."
