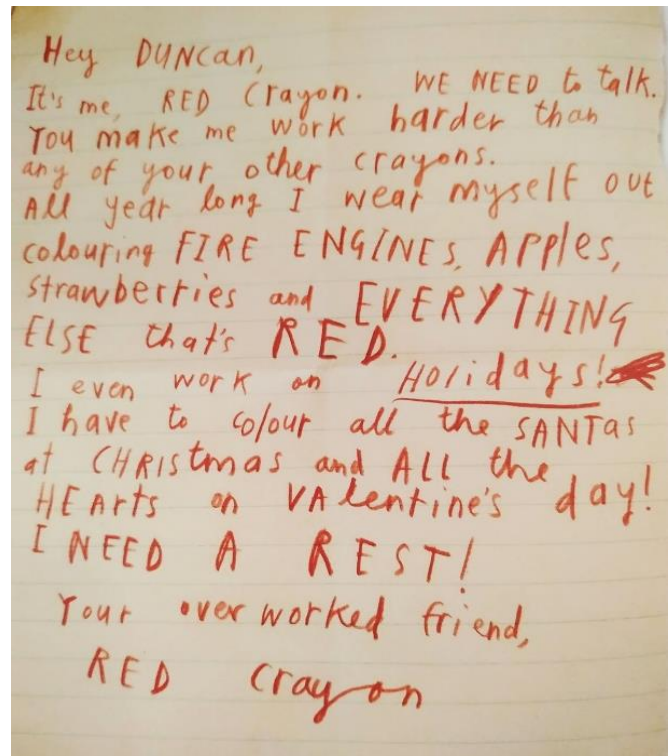


# Wednesday
