Wednesday — 'er' suffix

Adding -er to adjectives means 'more' and is used to compare. Normally you just add -er straight to the adjective but there are some exceptions.

If the adjective already ends in e, then just add r

Example: fine \rightarrow finer

When the adjective ends in y, change it to an i, and add er

Example: crazy \rightarrow crazier

If the adjective has a short vowel sound (a, o, i, e, u) double the last consonant then er.

Example: big \rightarrow bigger

Add the suffix 'er' to these adjectives using the rules.
