

Wednesday – 'er' suffix

Adding -er to adjectives means 'more' and is used to compare. Normally you just add -er straight to the adjective but there are some exceptions.

If the adjective already ends in **e**, then just add **r**

Example: fine → finer

When the adjective ends in **y**, change it to an **i**, and add **er**

Example: crazy → crazier

If the adjective has a **short vowel sound** (a, o, i, e, u) **double the last consonant** then er.

Example: big → bigger

Add the suffix 'er' to these adjectives using the rules.

strong	→	stronger
flat	→	flatter
loud	→	louder
hard	→	harder
fat	→	fatter
bright	→	brighter
tall	→	taller
short	→	shorter
thin	→	thinner
fast	→	faster
rude	→	ruder
long	→	longer
funny	→	funnier
quick	→	quicker
hot	→	hotter
close	→	closer
thick	→	thicker
wise	→	wiser
slim	→	slimmer
nice	→	nicer
