

Thursday - subtraction

$60 - 20 = 40$

$80 - 50 = 30$

$30 - 20 = 10$

$90 - 80 = 10$

$100 - 20 = 80$

★ $100 - 50 - 30 = 20$

★ $120 - 80 = 40$

Example: $70 - 30 = 40$

$= 7 \text{ tens} - 3 \text{ tens} = 4 \text{ tens}$

$4 \text{ tens} = 40$

$69 - 23 = 46$

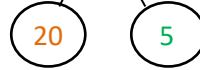
$87 - 34 = 53$

$42 - 27 = 15$

$74 - 38 = 36$

$31 - 26 = 5$

Example: $53 - 25 = 28$



$$\begin{array}{r} 53 - 20 - 5 = \\ \hline 33 - 5 = 28 \end{array}$$

I think that:

$$64 - 57 = 12 - 9 + 4$$

Do you agree or disagree?

I agree because they both equal 7. $64 - 57 = 7$ and $12 - 9 + 4 = 7$.
