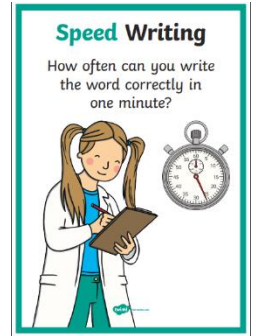

c) 24 children stand in groups of 3

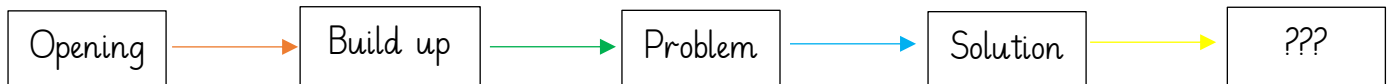
