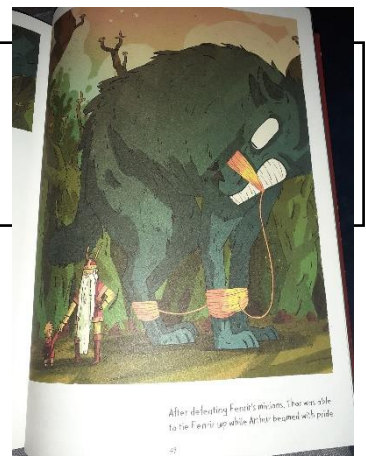
3. How did Fenrir feel when he bit Arthur's hand here? Why?
